



INTRODUCTION

He finished what was left undone in his previous lives and then guided many of his disciples and devotees to higher levels of consciousness. Almost all his disciples attained *gati*, the energy required to cross astral boundaries, and the majority of them attained *mukti* or long-term freedom from birth and death. He fulfilled his predetermined mission and his duty as a spiritual master.

Gurudev not only alleviated the physical and mental suffering of those whose destinies were intertwined with his, but also assisted several of them in ascending the spiritual ladder.
